

ODA Updates for SWCD Board Meetings December 2024

Please keep this as a resource and checklist to make certain your district is up to date on completing these annual activities. <u>ADP - Administrative Development Program</u> – The next ADP session will be held virtually <u>January 7th</u> at 1:00 pm with a focus on the 2025 Resources & Reminders. The following dates, locations and topics are for the remaining sessions planned in 2025. <u>March 25th – Legislative Process & Statehouse Tour (Rhodes Tower/Statehouse)</u>, <u>May 7th – SWCD Sales Tax Overview (Virtual)</u>, <u>June 24th – Planning-Program Growth & Evaluation (Bromfield Auditorium)</u>, <u>August TBD – Handbook Development & Review (Bromfield Auditorium)</u>, <u>September TBD – Human Resources/Leadership (Bromfield Auditorium)</u> and <u>October 28th – Auditor of State & Records Retention (Bromfield Auditorium)</u>.

<u>TDP - Technician Development Program-</u> In 2024, 20 TDP courses were offered with a total attendance of 607. The 2025 TDP classes will be announced, and registration will begin in January. Again, for 2025, SWCD staff will not need to pay a registration fee to take TDP courses.

Required Fraud Training Reminder – This year the Auditor of State's office released a bulletin outlining new fraud reporting and training guidelines for all public officials and employees. All current SWCD employees and board members are required to complete the training, which currently consists of an 8-minute video before December 29th. After December 29th all newly elected board members and employees are required to complete the training within their first 30 days. Annual Plan of Work – As 2025 moves nearer the development and approval of the district's annual plan of work is critical. This document should be developed in accordance with the district's long range strategic plan and in support of the district's mission. The annual plan of work serves multiple purposes. It provides a pathway for the district to achieve its objectives and is required to be submitted to the OSWCC to be eligible for state match funding. Within the Accountability portion of OSWCC State Match Policy SWCDs are required to submit an Annual Plan of Work for the current calendar year and document a quarterly review of progress towards implementing the plan. Under this section of policy districts are also required to utilize Beehive in accordance with the Beehive Use and Guidance Document which is attached.

<u>Beehive 2024 "Completed Events" Queries</u> - A quick reminder to please run your Beehive 2024 "Completed" Events queries to confirm that you have entered all completed events for the year. <u>All Calendar Year 2024 information should be entered in Beehive by January 31, 2025.</u> <u>Every SWCD</u> and <u>all staff members</u> have access to the "2024 Completed BMPs List" and "2024 Completed Education Events List" queries. These are saved query "Layouts" which can be found in Beehive Query, in the "All BMP Events" and "All Education Events" datasets respectively. These queries pull/show the data that will be in your End of the Year Technical and Education Summary Reports and in your Beehive 2024 "Annual Report".
